Day 1: Arrival in Mangshi

(D) 15 minutes transfer, elevation: 895m

Arrival in Mangshi on the flight booked by you (please specify the reference). Your journey officially begins here. After a brief rest at the hotel, you will have the opportunity to savor the local specialty—Dai Ethnic Hand-Grasped Rice. This traditional dish reflects the deep connection of the Dai people with the land, using fresh, locally sourced ingredients with a pure and natural taste. Before you embark on your exciting journey, this authentic dinner will introduce you to the local culture, serving as the perfect starting point to immerse yourself in the unique charm of the Dai people. **Overnight at Mangshi Feihua Hotel.**

Day 2: One village, two countries

(B, L, D) 120km, 2 hours' drive. Elevation: 895m.

Morning: Depart from your hotel for a 1.5-hour drive to the "One Village, Two Countries" scenic spot. Explore the border village, experiencing the unique blend of Chinese and Myanmar cultures. Afterward, visit the Jie Gao Border Gate, a significant crossing point between the two countries, and learn about its cultural and historical importance. Afternoon: Stroll along China-Myanmar Street, where you can browse local handicrafts, taste street food, and immerse yourself in the lively atmosphere of this border market.

Finish the day with a relaxing Burmese afternoon tea, enjoying traditional Myanmar snacks and tea.

Upon Arrival in Dali: After arriving, get ready for an exciting cycling adventure along the Erhai Lake Ecological Corridor, where you can enjoy the stunning views of Erhai Lake, the surrounding mountains, and the fresh, crisp air. The ecological corridor offers a peaceful and scenic route, perfect for taking in the natural beauty of Dali while cycling at a relaxed pace. **Overnight at Dali Golden Years Inn.**

Afternoon: Head to Mo Cui Tea for a tea-making experience, where you'll learn about the intricate process of tea cultivation, processing, and brewing. Enjoy the serene atmosphere as you immerse yourself in the art of tea-making and sample different types of tea. **Overnight at Dali Golden Years Inn.**

[Bai Ethnic Tie-Dyeing]

The Bai ethnic tie-dyeing experience in Xizhou is a traditional craft known for its unique dyeing techniques and intricate patterns. This centuries-old art uses natural plant dyes, such as indigo, and involves hand-stitching and binding to create beautiful designs. During the experience, participants can choose their fabric and patterns, then fold, bind, and stitch the fabric to prepare it for dyeing. Once prepared, the fabric is dipped into the natural dye, allowing the colors to penetrate and set. Afterward, the stitches are removed to reveal the magical patterns formed through the process.

This tie-dyeing experience is not only an opportunity to learn a traditional craft but also a chance to engage deeply with Bai culture. It allows participants to appreciate the charm of handmade art and experience the joy of creating something unique. Whether kept as a personal souvenir or given as a gift, these handcrafted tie-dye pieces hold both cultural significance and artistic value.
